Check with your District Good Turn chair or a District Scouting for Food chair for local food collection plans at monthly Roundtables.

Successful Collection strategies:

1. Gather in front of a local grocery store (with store management permission)
2. Door to door collection. (Always follow Guide to Safe Scouting policies!)
3. Event Collection. Check with local schools and colleges for football games that will encourage everyone attending to bring a canned food item to the game.
4. Set up a collection box at churches or schools that wish to support this year's Scouting for Food Drive.
5. Contact local media to help promote food drive efforts in your area.

Final Collection Day process: November 14th

Each unit will be responsible for collecting and delivering to their assigned food bank in Rutherford or Cannon County.
