Trail of Churches

A Nashville Historical Perspective of Historic Catholic Parishes

Trail of Churches guides registered participants through a tour of four Nashville historical Catholic Churches. The Tour begins by completing the questionnaire (or Passport) on your own house of worship. Once the passport is completed at your house of worship and the four on our Tour, you will earn a Trail of Churches patch shown below. This event will include experiencing a pilgrimage procession from one Catholic Church to another Catholic Church, attending Mass (optional) to observe the Catholic faithful celebrate the Holy Eucharist (communion), and observe feast day preparations for Mother Teresa.



Event Start date and time (Rain or Shine - *Be Prepared*): Saturday, September 17, 2016 from 9 a.m. to approximately 4 p.m.

Participants are asked to bring a sack lunch and a drink, and to provide their own transportation to the Catholic churches. The entire group will gather for an ice cream social at the end of the event, and participants will receive a patch if their Passport is complete. Carpooling is strongly advised.

This event practices Two-deep Leadership. Two-deep leadership is a safety procedure where every activity involving youth must have a minimum of two adults, preferably registered with a Scouting organization. CCOS will not allow Scout or unattended youth participant without parent, guardian, and/or without two-deep leadership supervision.

Participants on this Tour must dress appropriately and modestly. Participating males and females who are not affiliated in a Scouting program, should wear as a minimum clothing that covers both their shoulders and knees. **As a sign of respect, please no shorts, tank tops, uncovered shoulders, etc.** Scouts are asked to dress in Scouting dress attire (*e.g.* BSA Class A, or Girl Scout uniform equivalent, or other Scouting uniform only). **We are visiting houses of worship.**

Registration and Fees: Fee includes the Tour, Passport, patch, ice cream social, and handout materials. Registration is online at mtcbsa.org. Look for the Trail of Churches event on the home page.

Before Midnight, Saturday, September 3, 2016: \$5 per person

Sunday, September 4, 2016 - September 16, 2016: \$10 per person

Day of event, September 17, 2016: \$20 per person (cash only). If paying for this on the day of the event, you must **provide a #10 letter-size First Class USPS self-addressed stamped envelope**.
